10 digital images of your work on CD, or 2-3 video pieces for time based/ new media work, or 2-3 writing samples. All submissions must have been completed within the last three years. All images should be formatted as jpegs with a minimum width of 800 pixels and a maximum of 1024 pixels per side, saved at a resolution of 72 dpi. Label images with the following format: yourlastname1.jpeg, yourlastname2.jpeg, etc. Do not include any spaces, dashes or other symbols in the label. A DVD should be submitted for video/time-based/ new media work. The selection committee may review only a small portion of time-based work. Please consider this when selecting your work to be reviewed. Viewing priorities should be included on the DVD. All CDs and DVDs must be labeled with the artist's name.
Image list with title, date, media, and physical dimension of each image.
