Monson Arts Partners with *Making Migration Visible*

September 17, 2018 - Monson Arts—a new arts center and artists’ residency program supported by the Libra Foundation, is partnering with the ICA at MECA to offer a month-long residency this fall to one artist included in the ICA’s statewide exhibition *Making Migration Visible*. Ecuadoran-born artist Patricia Tinajero will join a cohort of ten artists and writers from all over the country who will be coming to Monson October 7- November 4 to live and work in newly renovated homes and studios. In addition to housing and studio space, artists-in-residence at Monson Arts receive all meals and a stipend to support the production of their work. If you’d like to see work made during the residency, there will be an Open Studios event on Thursday, November 1 from 3-5PM at the Monson Arts Center located at 35 Greenville Road in Monson. This event is free and open to the public.

Monson Arts is in its inaugural season of programming developed under Stuart Kestenbaum, former director of the Haystack Mountain School of Crafts and Maine’s poet laureate. The mission of the program is to provide time and space for creative work through residencies, workshops, and educational partnerships. More information is available at monsonarts.org.
