

HEERF QUARTERLY REPORT – STUDENT PORTION AS OF MARCH 31, 2022

As of March 31, 2022, HEERF I funds fully issued for a total of \$253,727. 102 MECA&D students were awarded Emergency Student Grants funded by the HEERF. These funds are the first of three rounds of funding and named HEERF I. These grants were awarded based on an application demonstrating qualifying expenses and eligibility for the Emergency Grant.

HEERF II funds are fully issued for a total of \$253,727. 136 MECA&D students were awarded an Emergency Student Grant funded by the second round of HEERF funding.

Of the 64 MECA&D students awarded an Emergency Student Grant funded by the HEERF III funds, 51 were new applicants. These HEERF III funds awarded totaled \$174,702.

We have issued funding for 331 students to date, which represents 57.8% of the eligible population.

There are 573 students in the 2021/22 academic year who were or could be eligible to participate in the Federal student financial aid programs under Section 484 of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, and thus are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
